



SHOCKING: The International Olympic Committee allowed Algeria's Imane Khelif and Taiwan's Lin Yu-ting—who were disqualified from last year's Women's World Boxing Championships after failing gender tests—to receive gold medals.

"I have never been hit so hard in my life," said Angela Carini, the female boxer from Italy who had her Olympic dreams shattered when she quit in tears after 46 seconds of being forced to fight Khelif.

Esra Yildiz Kahraman, a female boxer from Turkey, repeatedly made an "X" gesture at the crowd after losing to Yu-ting, indicating her opponent's unfair advantage.

Nancy Hogshead, three-time gold medalist at the 1984 Olympic Games, said, "Gender ideology will get women KILLED." We need to make our voices heard before it's too late!
