Censorship is the suppression of speech, public communication, or other information. This may be done on the basis that such material is considered objectionable, harmful, sensitive, or "inconvenient". Censorship can be conducted by governments, private institutions.

Why is censorship so bad?

Censorship is more extreme than biased information seeking because, in addition to biasing one's own online environment, censorship delimits the online content that other people are exposed to. Also, by silencing dissenters, censorship prevents them from voicing their views.

John Kerry Says the First Amendment is Getting in the Way of Online Censorship - Story by James Lynch •

Former secretary of state John Kerry recently spoke at a World Economic Forum panel and lamented the First Amendment for being a roadblock to countering online "misinformation" and "disinformation" about climate change.

Responding to an audience question about "climate misinformation," Kerry described how social media make it difficult to form consensus and said the First Amendment makes it difficult to weed out "disinformation" online.

"But, look, if people go to only one source, and the source they go to is sick and has an agenda, and they're putting out disinformation, our First Amendment stands as a major block to the ability to be able to hammer it out of existence," Kerry said.

"What we need is to win the ground, win the right to govern by hopefully winning enough votes that you're free to be able to implement change," he added, while acknowledging that different people have other visions for change.

Kerry's comments came 45 minutes into a World Economic Forum panel on economic development, held during its week of "sustainable development impact meetings," a series of panels primarily focused on climate change and international markets. The remarks caused an avalanche of criticism online, with many accusing progressives of openly supporting censorship.

For more than three years, Kerry was the Biden administration's inaugural climate envoy, until he left his post in March. He was the Obama administration's secretary of state from 2014 to 2017, helping negotiate the ill-fated Iran nuclear deal. After a decades-long career representing Massachusetts in the senate, Kerry, a longtime Democratic Party politician, lost the 2004 presidential election to incumbent Republican George W. Bush.

Online censorship under the guise of "disinformation" continues to be a hot-button issue four years after Twitter and Facebook censored the New York Post's reporting on the contents of Hunter Biden's abandoned laptop archive, leading up to the 2020 presidential election. The ability for government agencies to coordinate with social-media platforms was the subject of the Murthy v. Missouri Supreme Court case. The justices threw out the case in June for lack of standing, but the plaintiffs are trying to resume the litigation in lower courts.

Upon taking over Twitter, billionaire Elon Musk gave independent journalists access to internal documents and communications showing how government agencies pressured the platform into suppressing speech leading up to the 2020 election.

In August, Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg wrote a letter to the House Judiciary Committee admitting that Facebook made content-moderation choices under

pressure from Biden-administration officials and apologizing for censoring the Biden laptop story. House Republicans on the Judiciary Committee have produced multiple reports on its investigations into online censorship in the U.S. and abroad.

The Democrat plan has always been to prevent Donald J. Trump from becoming president again by railroading him with lawfare and jailing him, now it's been admitted by the nation's titular leader.

In a clarifying moment that perfectly illustrates what the modern Democratic Party has become, lame-duck President Joe Biden fessed up that "We gotta lock him up" just two weeks before the election, a contest looking increasingly possible that Trump will win.

On a day that Kamala Harris cleared her schedule to prep for a non-live interview with NBC News, the man who his own party overthrew told a small crowd in New Hampshire that the top opposition candidate needs to be put behind bars.

"If I said this five years ago, you'd lock me up: We gotta lock him up," the geriatric career politician said to applause while visiting a party campaign office in the Granite State. Seconds later, realizing the significance of his admission, Biden tried to clean it up by adding, "Politically, lock him up — lock him out, that's what we've got to do." "Our democracy is at stake," Biden said before his slip, using the

D-word that cloaks the Putin-like authoritarianism of those who have hijacked the American political system. "Think about it. Think about what would happen if

Donald Trump wins this election." "They're not even hiding it. The lawfare against my dad was always about election interference!" Donald Trump Jr. said in a post to X, sharing the clip.

"Joe Biden just admitted the truth: he and Kamala's plan all along has been to politically persecute their opponent President Trump because they can't beat him fair and square. The Harris-Biden Admin is the real threat to democracy. We call on Kamala Harris to condemn Joe Biden's disgraceful remark," Trump campaign national Press Secretary Karoline Leavitt said in a statement after Biden's inadvertent truth-telling went viral.

Understanding the magnitude of Biden's slip-up, party loyalists and regime media Muppets ran interference for the 81-year-old's shockingly un-American confession.

Alex Thompson of Axios said that he received a text from one individual who suggested the confession was unhelpful to Harris. "We gotta lock Joe up." He also shared a current administration official's dismissive damage control.

"For better or worse, no one is listening to him anymore and his words have little power and less reach. It's a blip. Gone in any meaningful way by mid-day tomorrow if it makes it that long," the official said.

Thompson also covered for Harris by sharing a video of her response after a crowd at one of her rallies called for locking Trump up.

Kamala deferred to the courts, but the corrupt politicized courts are clearly doing the bidding of the regime and are itching to get back to business once the election is done. "We're dealing with a totally different breed of cat now," Biden also said on Tuesday, smearing Trump supporters as enemies of "democracy" as he has repeatedly done.

"That was— the civil rights era was terrible. But we got a group now that is just literally, and I'm not one that is prone to hyperbole, but we have a group running the MAGA Republicans who have an anti-democratic attitude toward the way the Constitution functions," he said without a hint of self-awareness from a man who just called for jailing the opposition leader.

Entities backed by the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) are creating thousands of social media profiles impersonating Americans in an attempt to sway the 2024 presidential election. What separates these newer profiles from other China-based efforts to sow discord online is that they appear to be tailor-made to appeal to target demographics, and a few have found viral success, according to the findings of a report by Graphika, a social network analysis company.

One such profile was the Harlan Report, a channel dedicated to promoting newsworthy topics with a conservative slant. The account claimed to be operated by a U.S. military veteran who had lost faith in President Biden. Like many insurgent news channels, it promised to deliver "no opinions, just facts."

One of Harlan's videos, purporting to show Biden making a sexual remark at the annual NATO Summit in Washington, garnered 1.5 million views on TikTok alone.

The transcript overdubbed in the video was wrong, however, and Biden never said what was claimed.

Soon after, Harlan's profile began to change, first claiming to be a 29-year-old Trump supporter in New York and then a 31-year-old Republican social media influencer from Florida. But Harlan was neither a legitimate news source nor run by an American citizen, according to Graphika's report. It was one of thousands of accounts linked to the world's largest online influence operation. That operation, dubbed "Spamouflage," is a state-backed campaign from communist China with links to Chinese law enforcement. What's more, the campaign is going to great lengths to create Harlan-esque accounts for numerous demographics throughout the United States.

There are other accounts that create similar content, but tailored for Democrats, and others that aim to anger and polarize independents, further disenfranchising them from the political process altogether. Some have impersonated American anti-war activists, sharing memes calling former President Donald Trump a "fraud" and showing him in an orange prison uniform. Others question the legitimacy of Biden's presidency. While foreign attempts to influence U.S. elections are nothing new, their increasing stridency and varying levels of success are. What makes the Harlan Report persona unique, in

other words, is its success in finding a following and its pioneering role in targeting a niche audience the same way any advertiser would.

Those breakthroughs, in large part, are due to the increasing use of artificial intelligence (AI) and deepfakes, which the operators behind Spamouflage use to play on the likes and dislikes of a target audience.

John Mills, who previously served as the director of cybersecurity policy at the U.S. Defense Department, told The Epoch Times that the CCP is using AI to sort and interpret user data to better exploit users' fears and desires.

"People don't understand the immense power of big data, big data analytics, and the Al component that China has mastered and is using on an unbelievable scale," Mills said. "They [the CCP] are delivering a data stream tailored and customized to that individual, knowing their likes, their dislikes, their trigger points."

Likewise, an unclassified memo published by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) in July found that the Chinese regime "is seeking to expand its ability to collect and monitor data on U.S. social media platforms, probably to better understand—and eventually manipulate—public opinion." That much is evident in Spamouflage's tactics.

According to a report released by social media giant Meta, most of the Spamouflage accounts impersonating Americans did not start out by spreading fake content. Instead, they reshared posts created by real politicians and news outlets from either liberal or conservative sources to build followings and amplify divisive content. As those followings grew, and their operators learned more about their followings, the profiles changed, both in who they claimed to be and in the type of content they delivered. Mills said the technique used to identify and exploit Americans was essentially a new iteration of the same type of profiling that big tech corporations have used for years to track consumer preferences. "When I'm looking for a trailer hitch [online], that commercial for a trailer hitch follows me wherever I go," he said.

"Now, China has taken what our big tech was doing, but they're doing it on a much grander scale, with a much more sinister agenda, and without any semblance of bumper cushions or guardrails." Despite this increasing success in stoking tensions in the United States, however, the U.S. government had provided virtually no guidance on how everyday Americans can identify, report, or counter foreign influence operations online.

The Epoch Times requested comment on the matter from the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA). CISA declined to comment and instead referred The Epoch Times to the ODNI. The ODNI did not return multiple requests for comment on the matter. When asked what actions the State Department was taking to address

foreign influence in U.S. elections, a department spokesperson told The Epoch Times that it was "focused on the information environment overseas," and directed the paper to the

Department of Homeland Security. The Department of Homeland Security did not return a request for comment. Likewise, Graphika, whose report does not offer any suggestions on identifying or countering the content examined, declined to comment on the matter. Andrew Thornebrooke

This week, Donald Trump set the political world afire with an appearance at a McDonald's in Bucks County, Pennsylvania. There, he donned the famous McDonald's apron, cooked up some fries and served customers at a drive-thru window. All the while, he looked like he was enjoying himself thoroughly — which he certainly was. Trump has the momentum, and he knows it.

But it's more than that. Whatever Trump's other failings, at his root, Trump likes people. And not just people of his class or who share his background. He likes dealing with human beings. Two weeks ago, I had the opportunity to commemorate Oct. 7 with Trump, where he met with the family of an American hostage held by Hamas in Gaza. Trump connected with them on an emotional level. Whether it's Jewish Americans from New Jersey dealing with the horror and tragedy of having their son held by the world's most vicious terror group or Pennsylvania voters who just want to meet Trump and pick up a Happy Meal, Trump is comfortable with his fellow Americans because he's unapologetically what he is.

That's simply not true of Kamala Harris. Off-script, Harris remains a disaster. Her "60 Minutes" interview with Bill Whitaker was filled with word slaw, spin and platitudinous drivel; her Fox News interview with Bret Baier flew completely off the rails, with Harris unable to defend even the most basic decisions by the Biden administration. She is apparently now taking time off the campaign trail to prepare for an NBC News interview as well as a CNN townhall — events that, for a normal candidate, would require zero prep time in a hotel conference room. Then again, this is the same woman whose staff had to hold a "mock dinner" to prepare her for a dinner with Washington journalists and newsmakers. Axios reported, "Harris aides even considered including wine in the mock prep so Harris could practice with a glass or two."

What's more, Harris seems to be a permanent resident of the uncanny valley. She does a mildly credible job of appearing warm and human ... but only just. Her interactions

always reek of the staged and the manipulated. Every move is calculated — and transparently so. Twelve-time Best Actress nominee Katharine Hepburn once reportedly described Meryl Streep's acting as too mechanical: "Click, click, click," she reportedly told biographer Scott Berg, "referring to the wheels turning inside (Streep's) head." That's Kamala Harris with actual, real human beings. And it shows.

Which is why the media have gone apoplectic about Trump's McDonald's visit. Trump's critics pointed out that the McDonald's was actually formally closed for his visit and claimed that the event was "staged" — a peculiar critique given that Trump has been the victim of two assassination attempts, and presidential campaigns require places of business to be secured before candidates enter. The critics even went so far as to attack the local franchise for its health record years ago. The desperation comes from an obvious place: This was a Trump win.
